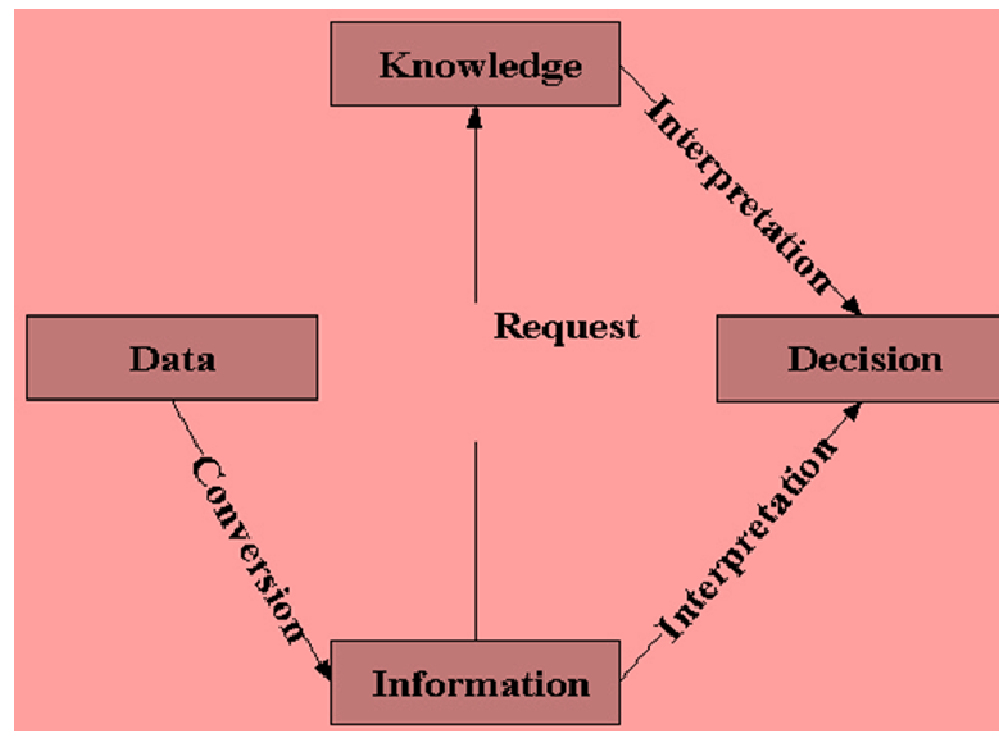
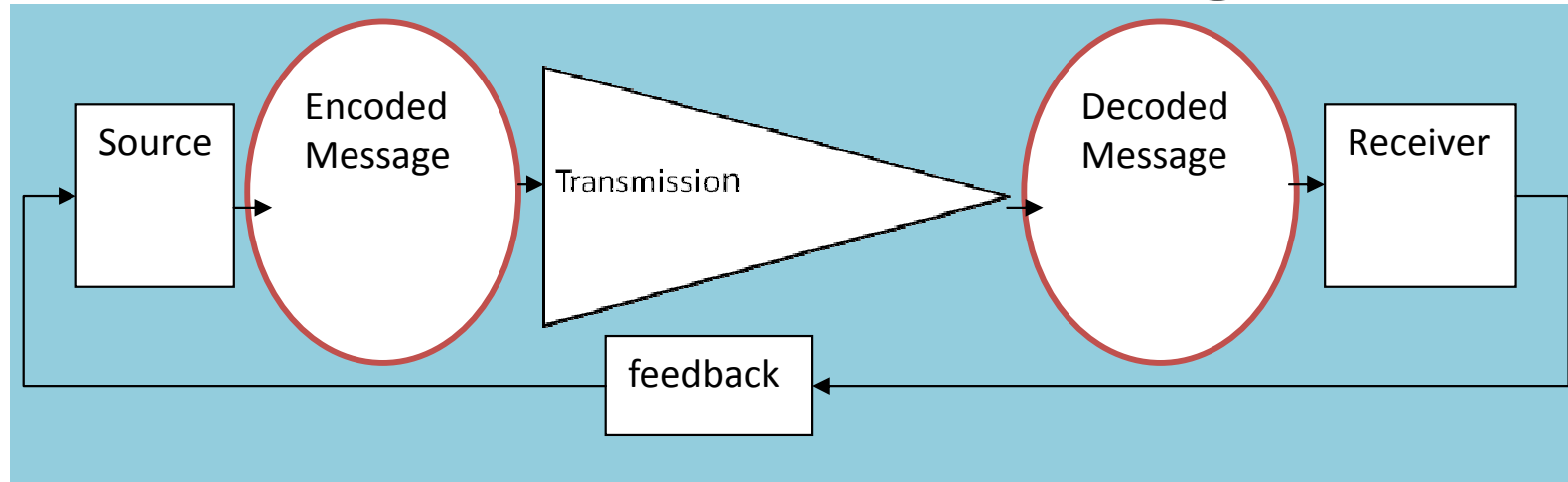

# Communication error

- **The Charge of the Light Brigade**

- This foolish action led the Russian officers to believe that the British were drunk.



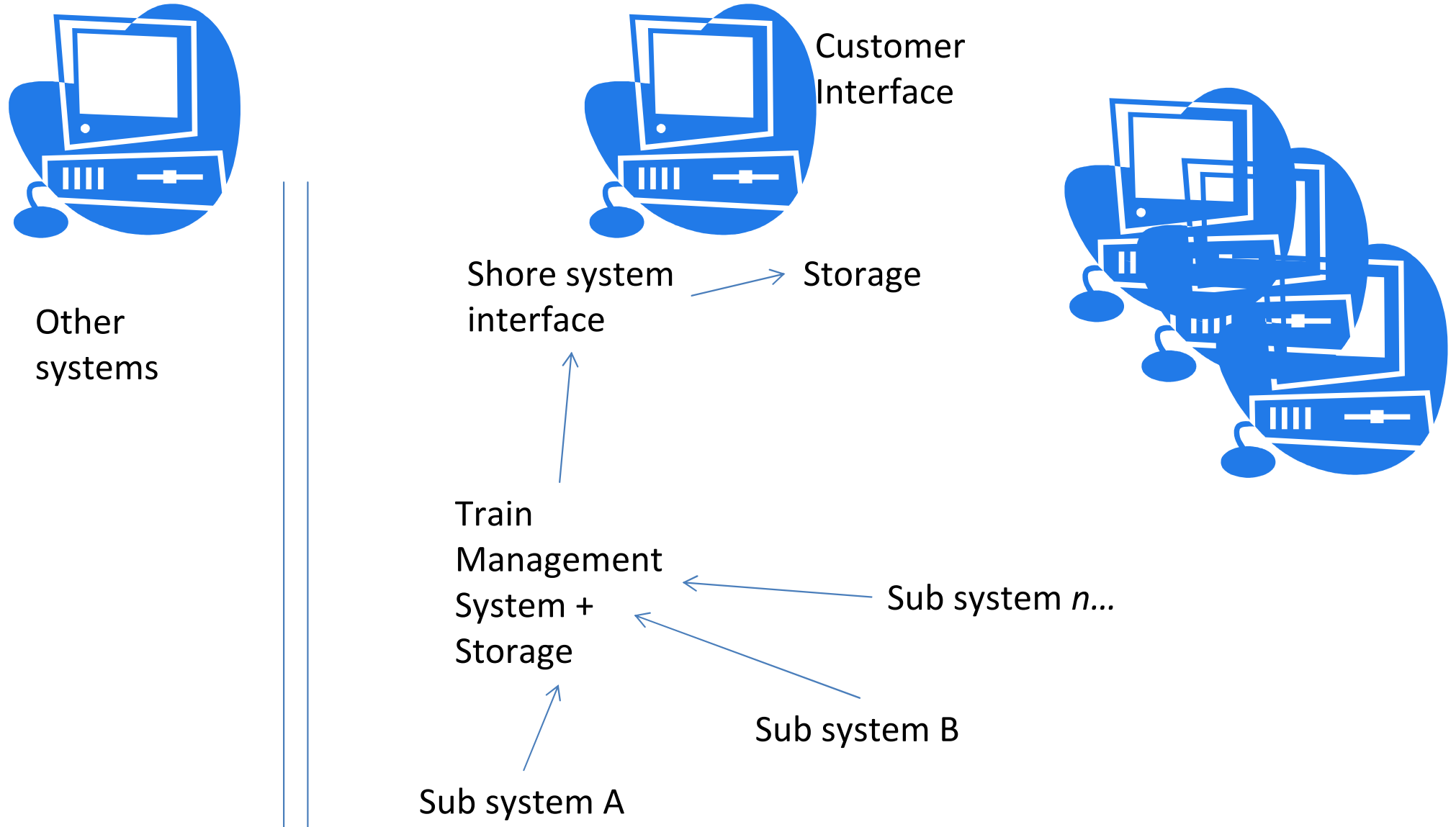
# ICT In UK Fleet

- Current Use of Communications Capability
  - GSM-R - *UK roll out*
  - Passenger WiFi - *Eastcoast*
  - CCTV – *Southern Trains*
  - ERTMS – *ATW followed by future UK Roll out*
  - Diagnostics – *All modern rolling stock (Desiro, Electrostar/Turbostar, Juniper, Plus retrofitment to existing vehicles*
  - Energy Consumption (Westcoast Mainline, London Midland)
  - Train control - *Scotrail and future Thameslink (Desiro City)*

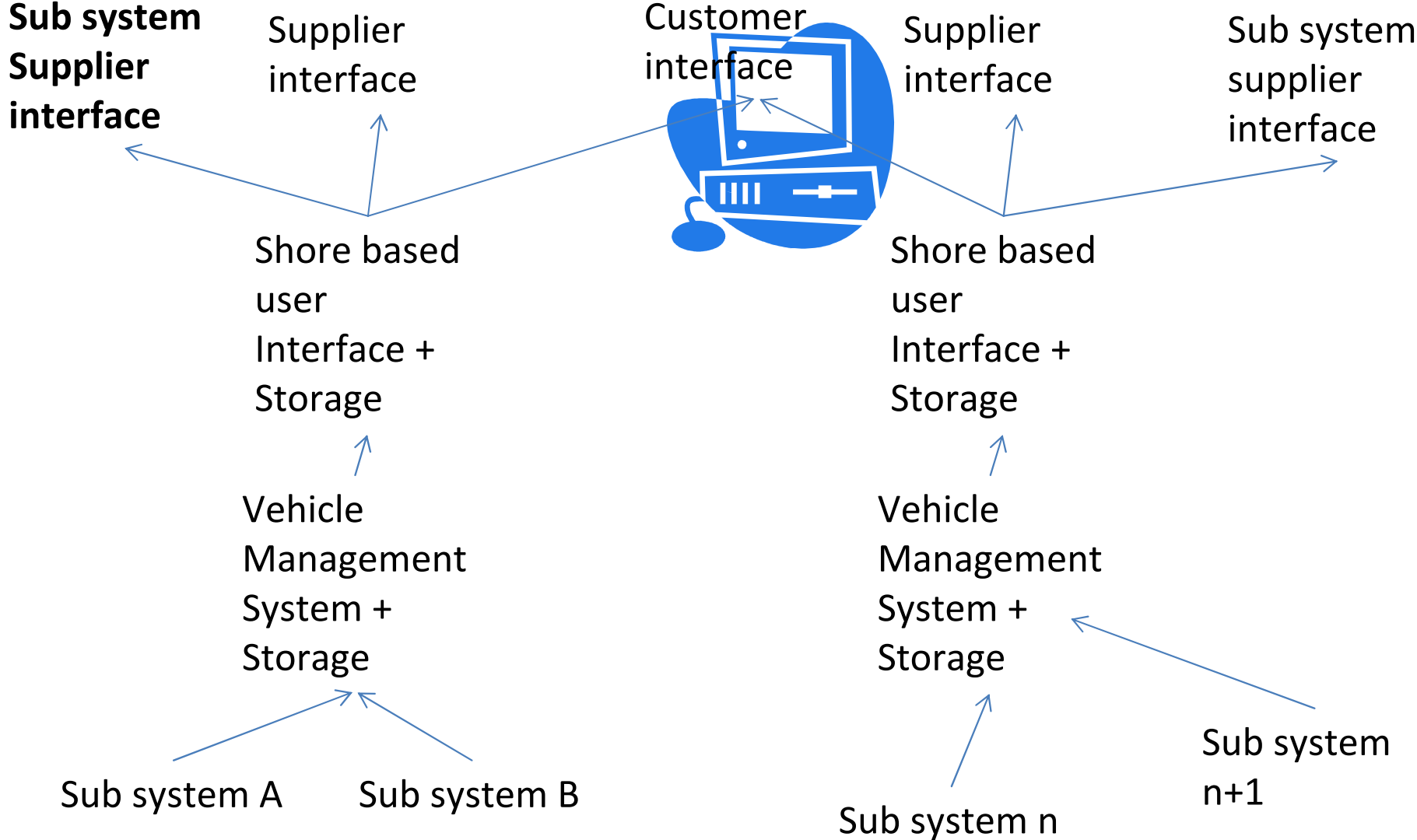
# Emerging Environment

- Customer requirements driving complexity in systems
- Passenger communications requirements driving GSM connectivity and bandwidth
- Passenger security (CCTV)
- Capacity increases requiring high performance
- Lower maintenance and operational costs requiring Condition Based Maintenance and Lean Manufacturing

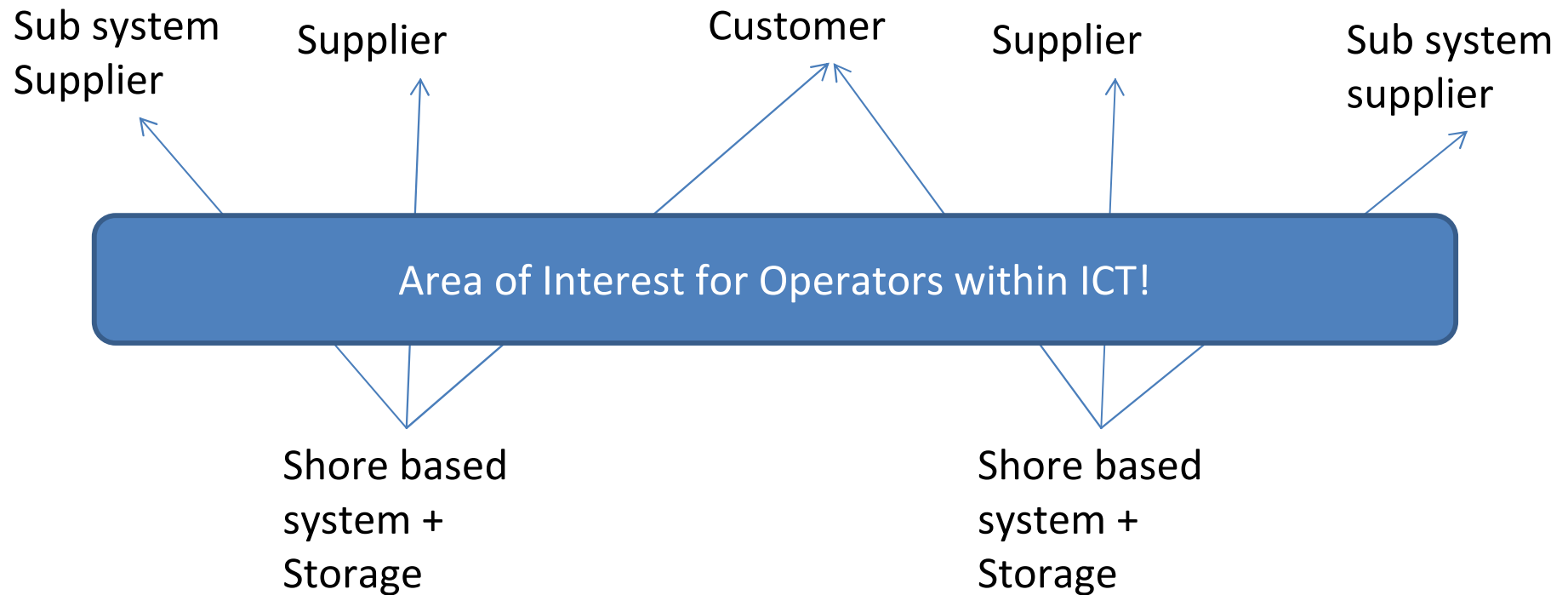


# Some Advantages

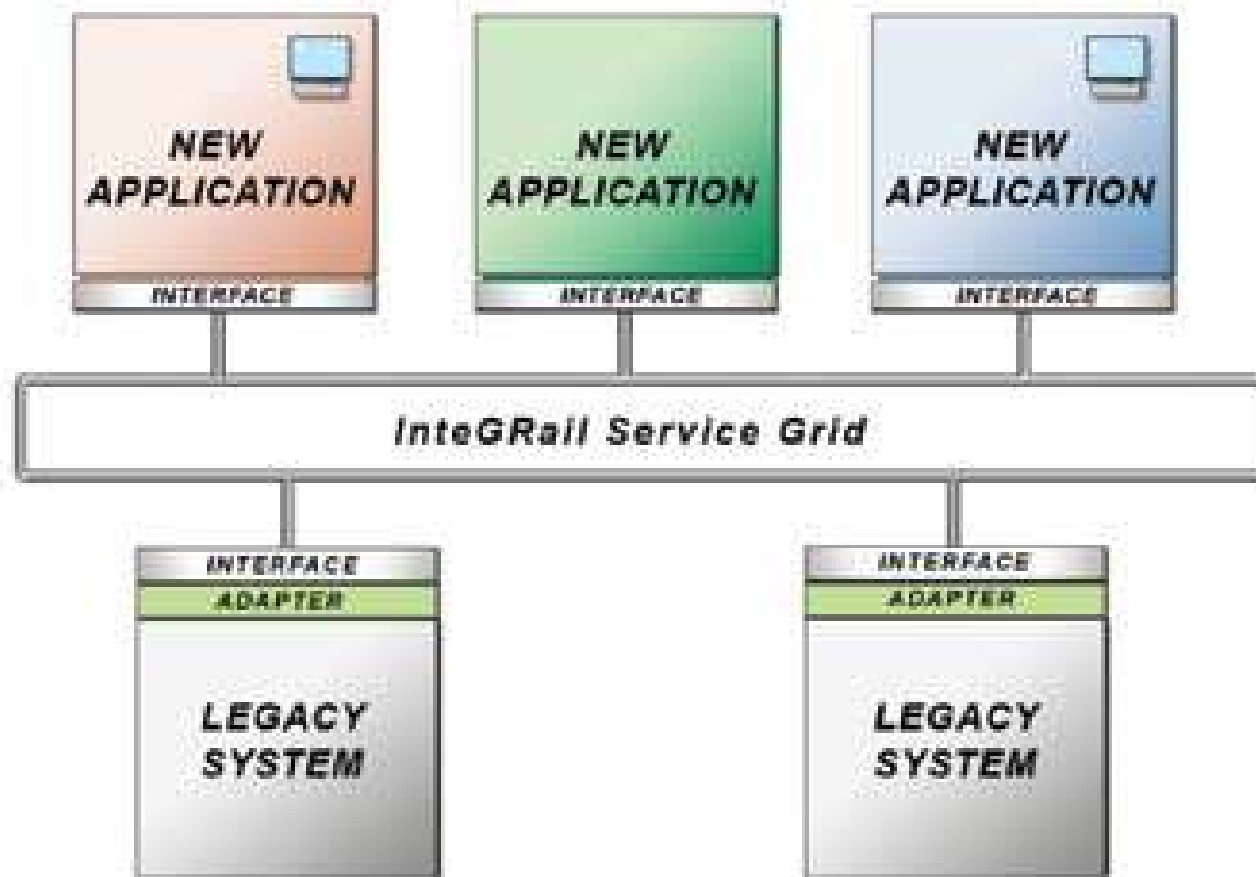
- Automates non value adding tasks

- Prevents stock outs



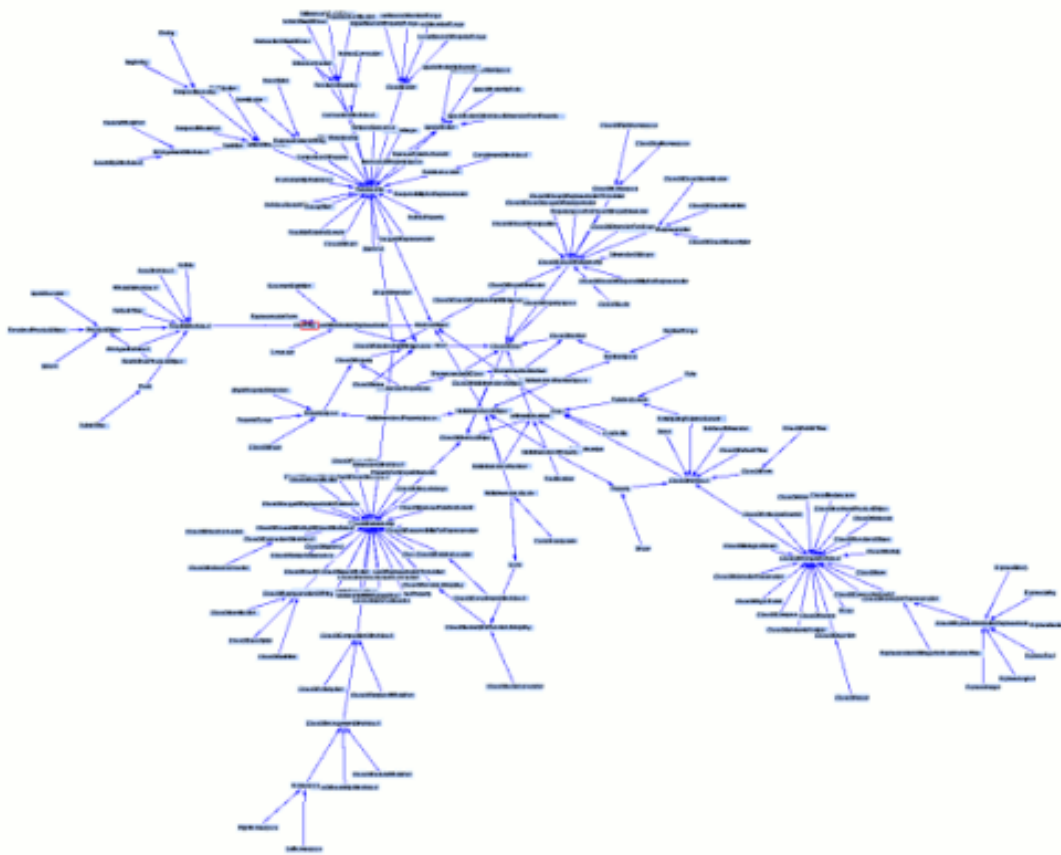
